Family-friendly behaviour

For the safety and enjoyment of all park visitors please observe the following rules.

The person who makes a camping booking is responsible for the behaviour of others staying at that site and must be present for the duration of the booked dates.

Anti-social behaviour and noise

- Noise restrictions apply after 10pm. Please do not disturb other campers after this time.
- Consumption of large quantities of alcohol, loud party groups and underage drinking are not permitted and will not be tolerated.
- Loud swearing and other offensive, noisy or dangerous behaviour will not be tolerated.
- No diving or jumping from the wharf at any time.

Fires

- Fires are only permitted in designated BBQs, portable BBQs or fire pits. Only gas fires are permitted at campsites or any other location.
- Use of the fire pits must be pre-booked with the Camp Ground Manager while at the site, on the intended day of use only.
- Fire hoses must only be used in emergencies.

Safety

- Spearguns and handspears are not permitted in the Park or at the Basin campground.
- Children under 18 must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.

General

- Do not feed, disturb or chase the wildlife.
- All campers must be able to provide identification if requested by a National Parks and Wildlife Service officer.
- All rubbish must be deposited into the litter bins provided.

National Parks and Wildlife Service staff will direct anyone not complying with these rules under the National Parks and Wildlife Act and Regulations, legislation.nsw.gov.au/#/view/regulation/2009/427/full or anyone behaving in an offensive, noisy or dangerous manner, to leave the area immediately. All fees paid will be forfeited. In addition, an on-the-spot fine may be applied.
